Day 13	Wed 20 Jan		After breakfast, game drive excursion with picnic lunch on floor of crater. Dinner and overnight at lodge.
Day 14	Thur 21 Jan	07h30	After breakfast, transfer to Serengeti mobile tented camp in Ndutu area. Dinner and overnight at the camp.
Day 15	Fri 22 Jan		Breakfast in camp. Morning & afternoon game drives in the Serengeti. Lunch, dinner and overnight at the camp.

Day 16	Sat 23 Jan	07h00 10h00 11h00	Transfer to airstrip for domestic flight to Kilimanjaro airport. After immigration and customs formalities we depart for 1 hour flight to Entebbe, Uganda On arrival in Entebbe the passengers will be split into two groups. Group 1 will visit the chimpanzees on Ngamba Island and Group 2 will enjoy an excursion to Jinja, source of the Nile . Dinner & overnight at the Imperial Resort Beach Hotel . Optional: 2 night gorilla tracking experience available in Rwanda / Uganda. (Rate & availability on request).
Day 17	Sun 24 Jan	08h00	The two groups of passengers exchange excursions today with Group 2 visiting the chimpanzees on Ngamba Island with Group 1 enjoying the excursion to Jinja, source of the Nile. Dinner & overnight at the hotel.
Day 18	Mon 25 Jan	08h00 12h00	After breakfast transfer to Entebbe Airport for 2 ½ hour flight to Khartoum, Sudan Transfer to the Burj Al Fateh Hotel for lunch. Afternoon visit to Omdurman Old Quarter & Market place. Dinner & overnight at hotel.
Day 19	Tue 26 Jan	09h00	After breakfast enjoy a day tour to Meroe with lunch en route. Dinner & overnight at hotel.
