04 February – 06 February 2010

Parc National des Volcans

Rovos Rail invites you to participate in an optional excursion tracking the Gorilla's in Rwanda. Parc National des Volcans in Rwanda is part of the Virunga Trinational Conservation Area, the single most important mountain Gorilla habitat in the world. Spend 2 nights at Virunga Lodge, an eco-lodge with 8 bandas overlooking the Virunga volcanoes and the lakes Ruhondo and Bulera.

Day 10	Thu 04 Feb	11h00	On arrival in Entebbe and after clearing customs, a private charter flight will take you to Kigali in Rwanda where you will be met by your guides and transferred to the lodge (about 3 hour drive). The journey north goes through the beautiful terraced hillsides that characterise much of Rwanda's landscape, gradually climbing to the base of the awesome Virunga volcanoes, sometimes with as many as five peaks visible. Overnight at Virunga Lodge, Rwanda.
Day 11	Fri 05 Feb		Go gorilla tracking through the light mountain forest on the slopes of the Virungas, this is a magical experience. If you are lucky you can get to the gorillas, spend an hour with them and be back at the base in time for a late lunch. Some gorilla families however are more elusive and tracking can take a full day, especially when it is wet and muddy. Tracking in Rwanda requires stamina and can often take most of the day. Please appreciate that the Gorilla sighting cannot be guaranteed. Overnight at Virunga Lodge, Rwanda.
Day 12	Sat 06 Feb		An early morning departure back to Kigali for your flight back to Entebbe to meet up with the rest of the group.

Tour price includes accommodation, meals, excursions, all alcoholic and other beverages, laundry & a complimentary massage.
Tour price excludes visa fees, travel & personal insurance.

Visas may be required for South Africa, Zimbabwe, Tanzania, Uganda, Sudan and Egypt, **and must be acquired prior to arrival.** Passengers are requested to have yellow fever inoculations, and are advised to take anti-malarial precautions as might be prescribed before commencing the journey.
