Itinerary 2 • Uganda Gorilla Tracking

04 February – 06 February 2010

Bwindi National Park

Rovos Rail invites you to participate in an optional excursion tracking the Gorilla's in the Bwindi National Park, western Uganda. Bwindi Forest is home to approximately 350 mountain Gorillas. It has four habituated families and is also rich in other primate and rare bird species. Spend 2 nights at Bwindi Lodge, an eco-lodge with 8 bandas overlooking the primeval Bwindi Forest.

Day 10	Thu 04 Feb	11h30	On arrival in Entebbe and after clearing customs, a private charter flight will take you to Kayonza airstrip in Bwindi where you will be met by your guides and transferred to the lodge (about 45 minute drive). Arrive in time for lunch. In the afternoon there is an optional guided nature walk in the thick forest rich in birds, butterflies & monkeys. Alternatively go for a stroll around the Lodge or on a community walk. Overnight at Volcanoes Bwindi Lodge.
Day 11	Fri 05 Feb		Go gorilla tracking, walking up steep densely forested hills before finally coming across the gorillas camouflaged in the vegetation. An inspiring moment! Tracking in Bwindi requires stamina and can often take most of the day. Please appreciate that the Gorilla sighting cannot be guaranteed. Alternatively go for a leisurely nature or community walk. Overnight at Volcanoes Bwindi Lodge.
Day 12	Sat 06 Feb		An early morning departure back to Kayonza airstrip for your flight back to Entebbe to meet up with the rest of the group.
